Positive Animal Rabies Case

This is the 4th case for Kerr County in 2016

Animal Submitted: Skunk

Date of Incident 01/23/2016

Where: Kerr County – 100 Block of Lark Spur, Mountain Home

How: Saturday January 13, 2016, a resident observed a skunk deceased in the front yard. Kerr County Animal Services the Local Rabies Control Authority was notified and received the skunk. The skunk was sent for testing on January 25, 2016. Positive rabies results were received Wednesday January 27, 2016. There was no known human or pets exposure.
