## Positive Animal Rabies Case

This is the 6<sup>th</sup> case for Kerr County in 2016

Animal Submitted: Cat

Date of Incident 2-17-16

Where: County: 100 blk of Deer Run Dr., Mountain Home

How: A woman noticed a cat she had been feeding was acting strange on Monday at which time she had brought the cat in her home for care and observation. Wednesday the cat passed away in the owner's home and was taken to Kerrville Vet Clinic and submitted for rabies testing. After finding out the positive results of the cat on Friday the 19<sup>th</sup> the woman informed Kerrville Vet Clinic and Kerr County Animal Services the Local Rabies Control Authority she had been bitten by the positive rabid cat on Monday. The owner is now undergoing post exposure rabies shots. There is also (1) cat being placed in a 90 day isolation period as a result of possible contact with the rabid cat and is not currently vaccinated.

**You never know when a wild animal will visit.  
Make sure to keep your pets vaccinated against rabies.  
Do not attempt to feed or make contact with wildlife or stray cats and dogs.
