Positive Animal Rabies Case

This is the 7th case for Kerr County in 2016

Animal Submitted: Skunk

Date of Incident: 2-18-16

Where: County: 100 blk of Hoot Owl Hollow, Ingram

How: A skunk was found in a shallow hole near the porch of the resident. The animal exhibited abnormal behavior associated with rabies. There is no known contact however there are cats and dogs in the area. The skunk was collected and submitted for testing by Kerr County Animal Services the Local Rabies Control Authority on 2-18-16. The positive results were received 2-19-16.

Do not attempt to feed or make contact with wildlife or stray cats and dogs.
