## Positive Animal Rabies Case

This is the 9th case for Kerr County in 2016

Animal Submitted: Skunk

Date of Incident: 3-5-16

Where: County: 400 blk. of Avenue C, Center Point

How: A skunk was found in the front yard of a resident on Avenue C in Center Point. The animal exhibited abnormal behavior associated with rabies. Residents in the neighborhood noticed a cat in the immediate area of the skunk, so it is believed there was a possibility of contact between the cat and skunk. It is unknown if the cat is a pet or feral. The skunk was collected by Kerr County Animal Services the local Rabies Control Authority on 3-5-16 and sent for testing on 3-7-16. The positive results were received 3-9-16.
