Positive Animal Rabies Case

This is the 10th case for Kerr County in 2016

Animal Submitted: Skunk

Date of Incident: 3-11-16

Where: County: 400 Block of Cypress Estates, Ingram

How: A deceased skunk was found in the kennel of a resident's dogs on Cypress Estates in Ingram. The skunk was not there the night prior and the dogs were in the kennel at the time it was found. The skunk was collected by Kerr County Animal Services the local Rabies Control Authority on 3-11-16 and sent for testing on 3-14-16. The positive results were received 3-15-16. Since there was possible contact with the dogs which are currently vaccinated both dogs will undergo a 45 day isolation period as required by The Texas Department State Health Services.
