Positive Animal Rabies Case

This is the 11th case for Kerr County in 2016

Animal Submitted: Skunk

Date of Incident: 3-21-16

Where: County: Angel Heaven Way, Mountain Home

How: A dead skunk was found in the yard of a resident on Angel Heaven Way in Mountain Home. The skunk is believed to have been killed by one of the resident's dogs. There are a total of 4 dogs which may have been in contact with the skunk. The skunk was collected by Kerr County Animal Services The Local Rabies Control Authority on 3-21-16 and sent for testing on 3-22-16. The positive results were received 3-23-16. As required by Texas Health and Safety Code the unvaccinated dogs are undergoing a 90 isolation.

**You never know when a wild animal will visit.
Make sure to keep your pets vaccinated against rabies.
Do not attempt to feed or make contact with wildlife or stray cats and dogs.
