Positive Animal Rabies Case

This is the 12th case for Kerr County in 2016

Animal Submitted: Skunk

Date of Incident: 3-26-16

Where: County: Midway, Mountain Home

How: A resident was alerted by his dog of a skunk which was chased under the house. The skunk then proceeded to chase the dogs when it was shot and the Sheriff's Department was contacted. Kerr County Animal Services The Local Rabies Control Authority was then contacted. The skunk was submitted for testing on 3-28-16. The positive results were received 3-29-16. As required by Texas Health and Safety Code the vaccinated dogs are undergoing a 45 isolation.
