Positive Animal Rabies Case

This is the 13th case for Kerr County in 2016

Animal Submitted: Skunk

Date of Incident: 3-30-16

Where: 100 Block of Timber Wood Rd, Kerrville

How: A resident found a deceased skunk on their property in the same area where their three dogs were currently being contained. Kerr County Animal Services the Local Rabies Control Authority was then contacted. The skunk was contained and submitted for testing on 3-30-16. The positive results were received 4-1-16. As required by Texas Health and Safety Code the vaccinated dogs are undergoing a 45 day isolation.

**You never know when a wild animal will visit.
Make sure to keep your pets vaccinated against rabies.
Do not attempt to feed or make contact with wildlife or stray cats and dogs.
