Positive Animal Rabies Case

This is the 14th case for Kerr County in 2016

Animal Submitted: Skunk

Date of Incident: 4/1/2016

Where: 200 Block of West Elizabeth Drive, Mountain Home

How: A resident found a skunk interacting with their cat on their property. The resident then dispatched the skunk and notified Kerr County Animal Services the Local Rabies Control Authority. The skunk was contained and submitted for testing on 4-3-16. The positive results were received 4-5-16. As required by Texas Health and Safety Code the vaccinated cat is undergoing a 45 day isolation.

**You never know when a wild animal will visit.
Make sure to keep your pets vaccinated against rabies.
Do not attempt to feed or make contact with wildlife or stray cats and dogs.
