Positive Animal Rabies Case

This is the 16th case for Kerr County in 2016

Animal Submitted: Bat

Date of Incident: 4/5/2016

Where: 300 Block of Center Point Drive, Center Point

How: A resident observed their dogs sniffing at a bat on their property. The resident then notified Kerr County Animal Services the Local Rabies Control Authority. The bat was contained and submitted for testing on 4-5-16. The positive results were received 4-6-16. As required by Texas Health and Safety Code the vaccinated dogs are undergoing a 45 day isolation.

**You never know when a wild animal will visit.
Make sure to keep your pets vaccinated against rabies.
Do not attempt to feed or make contact with wildlife or stray cats and dogs.
