Positive Animal Rabies Case

This is the 17th case for Kerr County in 2016

Animal Submitted: Dog

Date of Incident 4-6-16

Where: County: 100 blk. Jade Loop, Kerrville Vogue / Blue Ridge Mobile Home Park

How: The owner of a dog noticed her dog starting to act strangely a few days prior to April 6th; the dog was transported to Town & Country Animal Hospital for assessment. The vet associated the symptoms with signs of rabies. On **4-6-16** Kerr County Animal Services The Local Rabies Control Authority was notified of the situation and the animal was received and submitted for rabies testing that same day. The Positive results were received **4-7-16**. Also exposed to the rabid dog were eight (8), seven (7) week old puppies, the immediate family including 3 children and the neighborhood of multiple visiting kids. **Anyone with possible exposure to the mother dog or the litter of puppies is highly advised to seek post exposure rabies vaccinations'.**

**You never know when a wild animal will visit.
Make sure to keep your pets vaccinated against rabies.
Do not attempt to feed or make contact with wildlife or stray cats and dogs.
