Positive Animal Rabies Case

This is the 18th case for Kerr County in 2016

Animal Submitted: Raccoon

Date of Incident 04/07/2016

Where: 300 Block of Elm Pass II Road, Center Point

How: A resident was alerted to a raccoon on their property by their dog late in the evening; the raccoon was dispatched and Kerr County Animal Services the Local Rabies Control Authority was notified the following day. There may have been possible pet contact. The raccoon was sent for testing on April 11, 2016. Positive rabies results were received April 13, 2016. As required by state law a 45 day isolation period for the vaccinated dog must be observed to ensure its safety as well as the safety of the owners and the public's health & safety.

**You never know when a wild animal will visit.
Make sure to keep your pets vaccinated against rabies.
Do not attempt to feed or make contact with wildlife or stray cats and dogs.
