## Positive Animal Rabies Case

This is the 19<sup>th</sup> case for Kerr County in 2016

Animal Submitted: Skunk

Date of Incident: 4/11/2016

Where: 200 Block of Bob White, Kerrville

How: A deceased skunk was found in the kennel of a resident's dogs on by the property owner. The skunk was collected by Kerr County Animal Services the local Rabies Control Authority and sent for testing on April 11, 2016. The untestable results were received April 13, 2016. Since there was possible contact with the vaccinated dogs and the skunk was untestable the dogs will undergo a 45 day isolation period as required by The Texas Department of State Health Services.

Make sure to keep your pets vaccinated against rabies.  
Do not attempt to feed or make contact with wildlife or stray cats and dogs,  
Contact Kerr County Animal Services or Local Law Enforcement.**
