Positive Animal Rabies Case

This is the 20th case for Kerr County in 2016

Animal Submitted: Skunk

Date of Incident: 4/14/2016

Where: 3400 Block of Highway 41, Mountain Home

How: The property owner was alerted by the family dog to a skunk near their home. The skunk was killed by the dog and Kerr County Animal Services the local Rabies Control Authority was notified. The skunk was collected and sent for testing on April 14, 2016. The positive results were received April 15, 2016. Since there was pet contact; the vaccinated dog will undergo a 45 day isolation period as required by The Texas Department of State Health Services.

Make sure to keep your pets vaccinated against rabies.
Do not attempt to feed or make contact with wildlife or stray cats and dogs,
Contact Kerr County Animal Services or Local Law Enforcement.**
