## Positive Animal Rabies Case

This is the 21<sup>st</sup> case for Kerr County in 2016

Animal Submitted: Skunk

Date of Incident: 4/15/2016

Where: 100 Block of Rough Creek Road, Mountain Home

How: The property owner found a deceased skunk in the area where their dog was at the time. Kerr County Animal Services the local Rabies Control Authority was notified. The skunk was collected and sent for testing on April 18, 2016. The positive results were received April 19, 2016. Since there was possible pet contact; the vaccinated dog will undergo a 45 day isolation period as required by The Texas Department of State Health Services.

**You never know when a wild animal will visit.  
Make sure to keep your pets vaccinated against rabies.  
Do not attempt to feed or make contact with wildlife or stray cats and dogs,  
Contact Kerr County Animal Services or Local Law Enforcement.**
