## Positive Animal Rabies Case

This is the 22nd case for Kerr County in 2016

Animal Submitted: Skunk

Date of Incident: 5-10-16

Where: County: Nimitz Rd., Kerrville

How: Resident noticed a skunk at their home about 6pm on the evening of 5-10-16. There was possible contact with two of the resident's dogs. The skunk was collected by Kerr County Animal Services the Local Rabies Control Authority on 5-11-16 and sent for testing same day. The positive results were received 5-12-16. As required by Texas Health and Safety Code the vaccinated dogs will be placed on 45 day isolation.

**You never know when a wild animal will visit.  
Make sure to keep your pets vaccinated against rabies.  
Do not attempt to feed or make contact with wildlife or stray cats and dogs.
