Positive Animal Rabies Case

This is the 24th case for Kerr County in 2016

Animal Submitted: Fox

Date of Incident 5-28-16

Where: 200 Block of Verbena Lane, Center Point

How: On Saturday the 28th of May a resident notice a fox acting strange in his barn. After the fox was shot by the resident, the Sheriff's Office was notified and Kerr County Animal Services, the Local Rabies Control Authority was dispatched to the location. The fox was submitted for testing on 5-31-16 and the positive results were received 6-2-16. There was possible pet exposure. As required by state law a 45 day isolation period for the vaccinated cat must be observed to ensure its safety as well as the health & safety of the owner and public.
