## Positive Animal Rabies Case

This is the 26th case for Kerr County in 2016

Animal Submitted: Fox

Date of Incident 7-21-16

Where: County: Sleepy Hollow Circle, Kerrville

How: On Thursday the 21<sup>st</sup> of May, a resident notice a fox which had been killed by her dogs. Kerr County Animal Services, the Local Rabies Control Authority was called-out to the scene. The fox was submitted for testing on 7-21-16. The positive results were received 7-22-16. For the health and safety of the resident and the dogs, a 45 day isolation period will be required for both dogs. Both dogs are current on rabies vaccinations.
