Positive Animal Rabies Case

This is the 27th case for Kerr County in 2016

Animal Submitted: Bat

Date of Incident: 08/01/2016

Where: 600 Block of Meadowview, Kerrville

How: A resident observed a bat inside their home. The resident then notified Kerr County Animal Services the Local Rabies Control Authority. It is unknown how long the bat was in the residence and unknown human contact. The bat was contained and submitted for testing on 08/02/2016. The positive results were received 08/03/2016. As the Local Rabies Control Authority the resident was advised to speak with their physician for medical treatment because bites received from bats are difficult to feel and notice.

Do not attempt to feed or make contact with wildlife or stray cats and dogs.
