Positive Animal Rabies Case

This is the 28th case for Kerr County in 2016

Animal Submitted: Raccoon

Date of Incident 08/29/2016

Where: 2400 Block of Goat Creek Road, Kerrville

How: A resident was alerted by their dog to a raccoon found on their property. Kerr County Animal Services the Local Rabies Control Authority was notified and contained the raccoon. The raccoon was sent for testing on August 30, 2016. Positive rabies results were received August 31, 2016. As required by state law a 45 day isolation period for the vaccinated dog must be observed to ensure its safety as well as the health & safety of the owner and public.

Make sure to keep your pets vaccinated against rabies.
Do not attempt to feed or make contact with wildlife or stray cats and dogs.
