Positive Animal Rabies Case

This is the 30th case for Kerr County in 2016

Animal Submitted: Bat

Date of Incident: 09/15/2016

Where: 400 Block Horseshoe Ridge, Kerrville

How: A resident observed a deceased bat on their property. The resident then notified Kerr County Animal Services the Local Rabies Control Authority. The bat was contained and submitted for testing on 09/15/2016. The positive results were received 09/16/2016. There was no known contact with the resident's vaccinated pets. For the health and safety of the resident and their pets, a 45 day observation period and rabies booster will be advised for the cats and dogs.

**You never know when a wild animal will visit.
Make sure to keep your pets vaccinated against rabies.
Do not attempt to feed or make contact with wildlife or stray cats and dogs.
