Positive Animal Rabies Case

This is the 33rd case for Kerr County in 2016

Animal Submitted: Bat

Date of Incident: 10/26/2016

Where: Tivy High School, Kerrville

How: Students observed a bat on the northwest student entrance wall to the school. The faculty then notified Kerr County Animal Services the Local Rabies Control Authority. The bat was contained and submitted for testing on 10/26/2016. The positive results were received 10/27/2016. Due to unknown human exposure if any student, staff or faculty member that may have had contact with the bat are advise to contact Kerr County Animal Services and immediately consult with a medical professional. (KISD Interim Superintendent is in the process of notifying all Tivy High School students, staff and faculty)
