## Positive Animal Rabies Case

This is the 34<sup>th</sup> case for Kerr County in 2016

Animal Submitted: Raccoon

Date of Incident 10/28/2016

Where: 1600 Block of Lane Valley, Comfort

How: A resident's was alerted to a raccoon that was on their property. The raccoon was transported to Kerr County Animal Services the Local Rabies Control Authority. The raccoon was sent for testing on October 31, 2016. Positive rabies results were received November 1, 2016. Due to unknown exposure as required by state law, a 45 day isolation period must be observed for the vaccinated dog. The resident was advised to immediately consult with a medical professional due to contact with the raccoon.

Make sure to keep your pets vaccinated against rabies.  
Do not attempt to feed or make contact with wildlife or stray cats and dogs.
