

Ammie Rose Hollar Garrett Salter

In this story, Ammie Rose Salter, talks about her life in Kerrville after she and her first husband returned to live here after retirement. Before that time, however, Ammie Rose was a frequent visitor to Kerrville to visit her grandparents, the Tom Holdsworths, her mother's parents. She also graduated from Tivy High School during a period when her parents had returned to the area for a time.
