

## Robert Lee Mosty

Robert Mosty owns and operates a plant nursery in Center Point which was started by his father in 1907. In this history, he talks about his experiences in WW II. His unit was one of the first to meet liberated prisoners of war. He was wounded and taken prisoner and operated on by a German doctor in France. He talks about A&M, his work for the National Park Service and then about how it was to run a plant nursery in the 20s when he helped in his father's business, and later when running his own business. He tells how to start a Model "T", about his first radio and when they first got electricity and telephones in Center Point.
