

## CAPTAIN CHARLES SCHREINER HOME (Hill Country Museum)



Charles Schreiner's large Romanesque Home is one of four Kerrville area buildings on the National Register of Historic Landmarks. Designed by San Antonio architect Alfred Giles, it is built of native stone. The first phase was begun in 1879, the second in 1895, the third phase added porches and archways in 1897. Capt. Schreiner led the community in banking, ranching and mercantile activities. Recorded Texas Historic Landmark. (1927)
